TOURNAMENT RULES:

1. Eligibility: This tournament is open to all Seniors age 50 and over who are residents of the State of Idaho or card holders of the Idaho State USBC, with the exception of Professionals. Seniors who are not members of USBC must purchase membership prior to bowling the tournament.
2. Entering Average: Entrants shall use their highest USBC average from sanctioned league for the previous season (2017-18) or Summer League (2018) based on a minimum of 21 games or more. If neither average the bowler may use current average as of Oct. 26, 2018 based on minimum of 21 games. All others shall bowl scratch, Rule 319a-3 will be in effect.
3. Handicap: Handicap will be based on 90% of 220 in all divisions. Bowlers whose average exceed the base score of 220 will be negatively handicapped on a 90% basis.
4. USBC Rule 319a-2 will not be in effect.
5. Rules 319d – reporting all prior (Prize Winnings which has changed, please refer to the 2018-19 Playing Rules book) and 319e (Average Adjustment for Entry) will be required by all bowler. Tournament manger reserves the right to rerate or reject any entry prior to bowling.
6. Prizes:
 1. Winners in each division will receive a paid entry to the National Championship Tournament. The National Tournament for men and women will be combined.
 2. All prize monies collected in each division will be returned 100% to the participants in each division. Prize fund will be based on one (1) in six (6) entries in each division.
7. Ties - Co-Winners will be declared for prizes and awards. The champion for National competition shall be determined by the highest single game with handicap to break the tie.
8. A total of six (6) games must be bowled to qualify for State Champion in all divisions. They will be bowled in two (2) separate blocks. Bowlers may bowl all six games on the same day or different days.
9. Entry fee will be refundable at the discretion of the Tournament Director. i.e., death, injury, health issues, etc. prior to bowling the first game of the tournament.
10. Bowlers shall be required to check in one (1) hour prior to scheduled time to bowl. USBC membership cards will be required for check in.
11. Bowlers shall be allowed to practice on Tournament lanes within one (1) hour of time scheduled to bowl tournament. This will be at the discretion of the bowling center management and lane availability.
12. Use of abrasives and cleaners will be prohibited.
13. The Annual meeting of the Idaho State Seniors will be held on Saturday, Oct. 27, 2018 at 6:00 PM in the meeting room at Westy's. All senior bowlers are welcome to attend.
14. Any rules not covered herein will be in accordance with USBC playing rules.

EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2017 - TOURNAMENT RULE CHANGES

Rule 319d. Reporting Prior Prize Winnings: Requires reporting of prize money won in excess of \$300 in a single event, the combined prize money won in excess of \$500 in a tournament, and/or the combined money won in excess of \$1000 in all tournaments competed in within 12 months.

Rule 319c. Average Adjustments (Rerating). Requires bowler to report any previous tournament adjustments/rerate unless tournament rules states otherwise.
