RULES – 2019 IDAHO STATE USBC WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

- 1) All entrants must be a member of, USBC and be an active member of their local Idaho association. A transferred member may bowl in the tournament if she has not already participated in the current year's tournament in the state from which she transferred.
- 2) The tournament shall consist of a four-woman team event, a doubles event, a singles event and optional ALL-EVENTS. Three consecutive games shall be bowled in each event and the total pins shall decide the winner. The total of nine games (three from each of the other events) bowled shall determine the all-events winner in each division. Participation in doubles and singles event shall be limited to one time only. Con bowl multiple teams but no more than two bowlers can remain the same. At least two bowlers must be changed.
- 3) Entrants will be requested to show their current USBC card. High School students who have not reached the age of 18 must furnish written consent, signed by their parent or guardian.
- 4) AVERAGES: All references to averages shall include averages established in Idaho USBC sanctioned leagues.
 - A) The highest sanctioned league average as of the end of the previous winter season, provided 21 games or more were bowled.
 - B) Use highest sanctioned summer league average as of the end of the summer league, provided at least 21 games or more were bowled.
 - C) Use highest sanctioned league average as of January 1 of the current season, provided at least 21 games were bowled.
 - D) Use highest current sanctioned league average as of the date bowling the tournament provided at least 12 games were bowled, subject to the approval of the association manager.
 - E) If none of the above averages are available, the entrant must bowl scratch (210).
- 5) DOUBLES PARTNERS OR TEAM MEMBERS WILL NOT BE FURNISHED BY THE IDAHO STATE USBC WOMEN'S BOWLING ASSOCIATION.
- 6) Handicap shall be 90% of 210.
- 7) Any person who bowls under an assumed name, or bowls under the name of an entrant who has been properly scheduled in the tournament and who is unable to attend, or any team that allows a person as stated herein to bowl on said team, shall, together with said person, forfeit their entry. All members who were involved in the affair and found guilty may be suspended from membership in USBC.
- 8) The entry for the tournament shall be \$25.00 per event – per bowler. \$9.00 is for bowling, \$3.00 for tournament operating costs, and \$13.00 for the prize fund. There is an optional \$5.00 Handicap and Scratch All-Events. Only those entrants who pay either or both of these optional fees shall receive prize money in that division.
- 9) Prize money paid into each event is returned to winners in that event only. Prize money is returned 100%. Prize money is paid for handicap scores in team, doubles and singles events only. Trophies are awarded for handicap and scratch first place winners. Prize money in the all-events is paid back only to those entrants who have paid their \$5.00 optional fee with their entry. If an entrant is scheduled for more than one team event and is entered into all-events, she will use the team event in which she rolls her first score as a regular member or as a sub.
- 10) In case of a tie for first place in any event, co-champions will be declared, with first and second place prize money divided equally and duplicate trophies and emblems awarded.
- 11) All entries postmarked the first post office business day following the entry closing date shall be accepted.
- 12) The pay ratio is at least 1 in 6. All-events pay ratio is at least 1 in 10.
- 13) **Any changes in scheduling must be done through the Tournament manager at least three weeks prior to the opening weekend of the tournament. Changes after the three week window should be made on an emergency basis only and are subject to availability. The Tournament manager will not accept telephone reservations or collect calls.**
- 14) Entrants shall bowl in the same order as listed on the entry form. An entrant bowling in all three events shall be entered automatically for the all-events trophy and emblem awards. An entrant may bowl in the team event without bowling singles and doubles, or bowl singles and doubles without bowling team but, if she enters singles, she must enter doubles and vice versa.
- 15) Rule 319A, C, D, and E will not apply.
- 16) In the event a team is unopposed on a pair of lanes, each frame shall be completed on one lane before the next frame is started on the adjoining lane. This rule shall apply to the singles and doubles events also. Pacers shall not be allowed in this tournament.
- 17) Any player or team arriving late shall begin playing and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Doubles event will be bowled first. If the entrant's doubles partner has not arrived by the time the doubles event begins and a substitute cannot be found, the entrant shall be permitted to bowl her games in the doubles event in order to qualify for the all-events.
- 18) SUBSTITUTE (S) Shall be allowed to take place in the lineup of the original entrant(s) and once entered into the game, shall complete the event. No limit on the number of substitutes. The Idaho State USBC BA assumes NO responsibility to provide substitutes. If the substitute chairman has been asked to provide a substitute by the request of a team captain, the substitute must be used for all requested events, except in the case of an emergency or disability. In case of a disability during team or doubles a substitute may be used if one is available. The combined scores are counted in either of these events. Only the actual score of the frames bowled shall count if a substitute is not available. Paid all-events are not transferable unless the substitute replaces the original entrant in all three events and the transfer is made by the association manager or assistant prior to the time of the substitute's participation in any event. THE CAPTAIN SHALL NOTIFY THE OFFICER ON DUTY OF ALL SUBSTITUTES AT LEAST ONE HOUR BEFORE THE SCHEDULED TIME OF BOWLING. A substitute will not be required to reimburse the entry fee paid or give the original entrant any prize money or trophy she may win. Averages must be verified by the substitute's local association manager.
- 19) BOWLERS SHALL BE CHECKED IN BY THE CAPTAIN AT LEAST ONE HOUR BEFORE SCHEDULED TO BOWL.
- 20) Telescores shall be the official scorer for the Idaho State USBC WBA Championship Tournament. Any score bowled in the tournament cannot be changed, altered or modified after it has passed by the official scorekeeper and team captain or individual contestant, except that, owing to a dispute or disagreement. The Idaho State USBC Tournament Manager or an Idaho State USBC Tournament Officer shall have the power to correct the score. All obvious errors shall be corrected by the tournament committee.
- 21) Overpayment of a tournament entry form will be held by the tournament manager until the end of the tournament. Overpayment of \$5.00 or less is nonrefundable.
- 22) Entrants are requested to wear suitable bowling attire when participating in the Idaho State USBC Women's tournament. Any bowler who is, in the opinion of the tournament officer on duty, conducting herself in a manner detrimental to bowling will be removed from that event. The tournament officer on duty shall have the authority to enforce this rule.
- 23) Entrants in the above competition do so at their own risk of personal injury. The Idaho State USBC shall not be liable for loss to personal property or personal injury received by a participant during travel to and from the Idaho State USBC Women's Championship Tournament.
- 24) The entrants whose names appear hereon, or their authorized replacements, hereby agree that the Idaho State USBC, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change, or premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergencies or cause relating thereto or resulting from, fire, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or causes beyond the control of the Idaho State USBC.
- 25) Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the tournament manager before the tournament prize payments are made.
- 26) There shall be no gambling during tournament play. Refer to rule 15.
- 27) ANY QUESTIONS NOT COVERED BY THE RULES WILL BE DECIDED BY THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE. The tournament shall be conducted in accordance with USBC rules governing state association tournaments and the USBC general playing rules.
